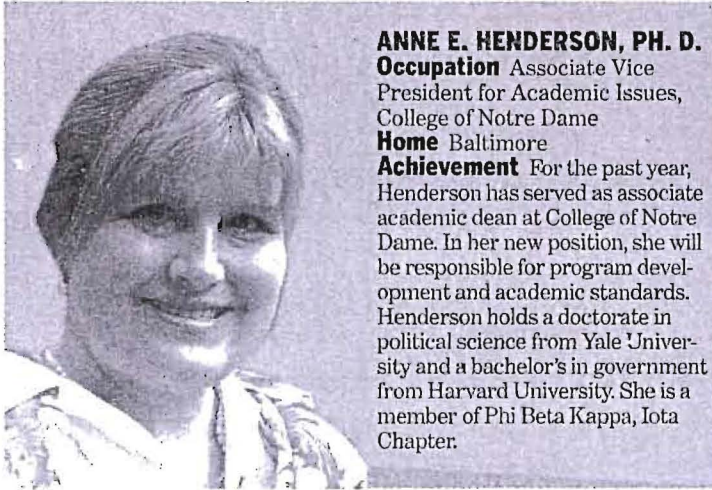
LAURENCE M. MERLIS
